What reading opportunities will we have?

- Class shared reading / 1:1 reading / reading own work back.
- Recognising and reading own name
- Link sounds to letters in reading and phonic activities
- Sharing topic books such as 'My Map Book' by Sara Fanelli, 'The Family Book' by Todd Parr and 'All Kinds of People' by **Emma Damon**

What will we learn?

- Understand the five key concepts about print:- print has meaning - the names of the different parts of a book- print can have different purposes - page sequencing - we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom
- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- Develop their phonological awareness

What opportunities will we have to practise our physical skills?

- Explore the small hall space and outside areas and field.
- Work together to play team games such as parachute
- Explore new equipment using different skills such as climbing equipment, balancing benches and hula-hoops.

What will we learn?

- Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills
- Go up steps and stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues
