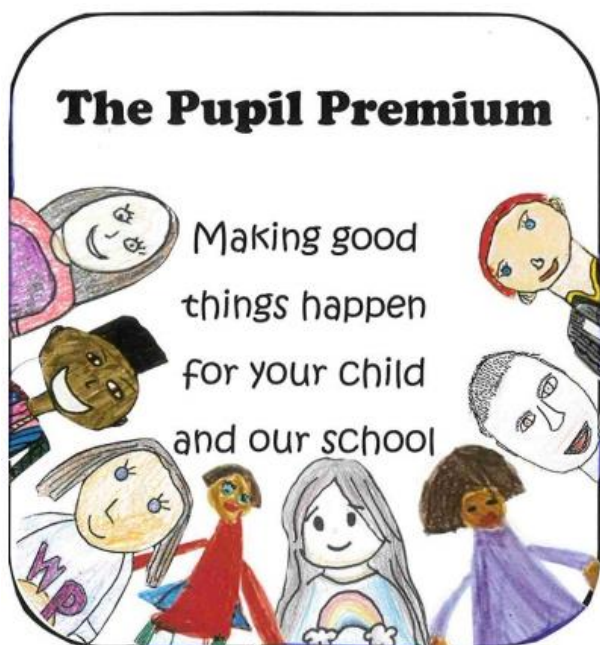

Pupil Premium Information for Parents



Did you know that extra money could be available to help your child's learning and development?

The Pupil Premium is extra government money which is paid to schools to support children's learning and development. It's quick and easy to find out if you can claim for your child.

Children from the reception year to year 11 may be eligible if they:

- are registered for Free School Meals (FSM)
- have been registered for FSM at any point in the last 6 years
- are or have been in care- please let us know this information if you haven't already
- have parents in the armed forces

*If your child could claim for FSM but takes a packed lunch to school, it's still important you register.

Why should I register my child for Free School Meals (FSM)?



- Children who are registered for Free School Meals (FSM) are entitled to the Pupil Premium.
- Your child isn't automatically registered for FSM, even though all children up to the end of Year 2 are entitled to receive a free school meal (this is the Universal Free School Meal).
