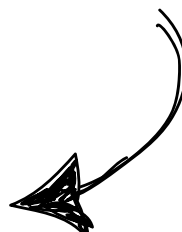

Thank you for your patience as we have been experiencing issues with our phone and internet lines.

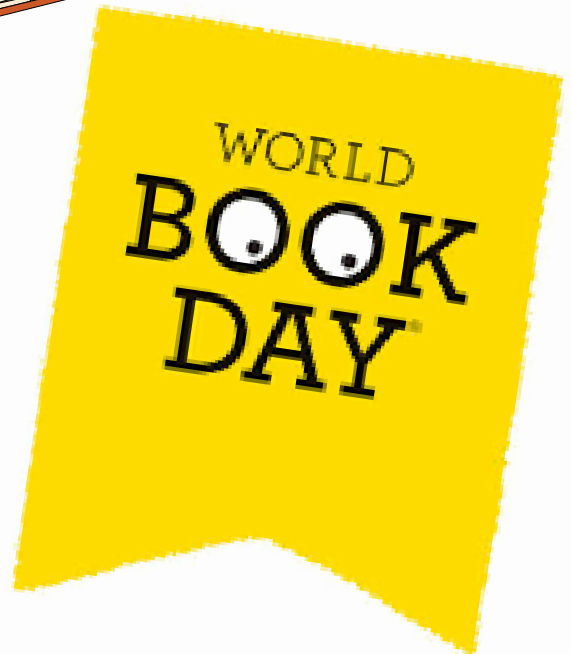
Both are now back up and running.

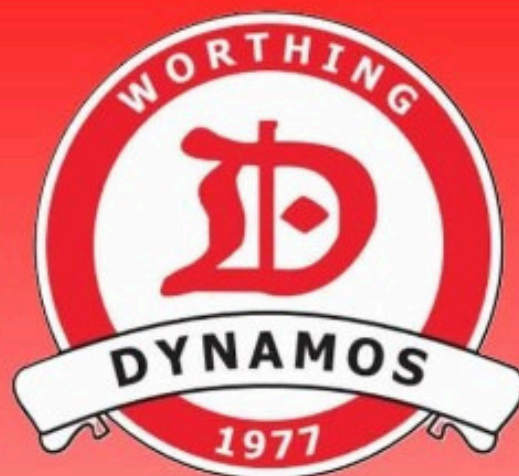
