Please could parents ensure that they supervise their children on collection from the classroom teacher and that they remain with them when leaving the school.

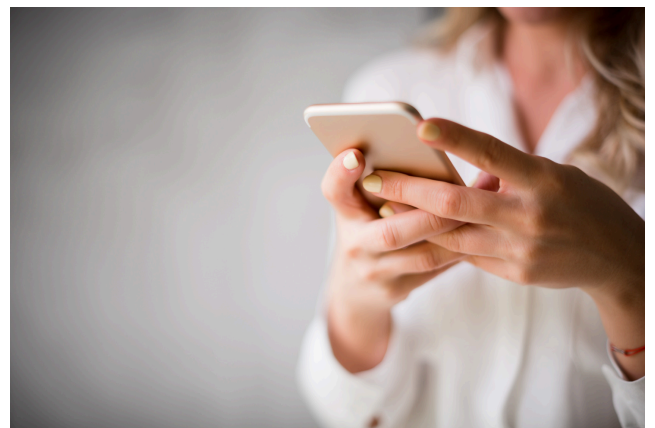
