

### To Book

To book a place at any of our clubs you will need to complete a booking form and a registration form.

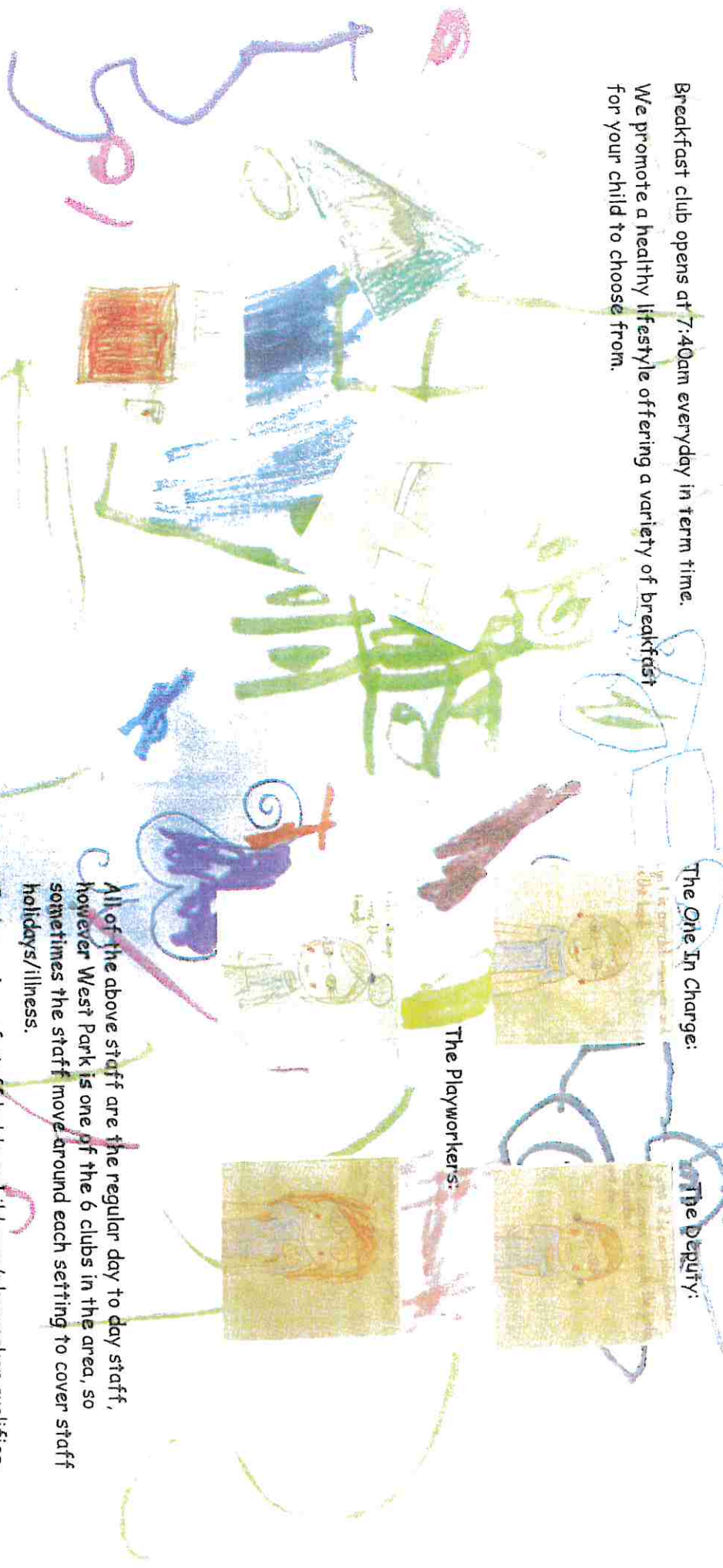

Each member of staff holds a childcare/playworker qualification or is working towards one.

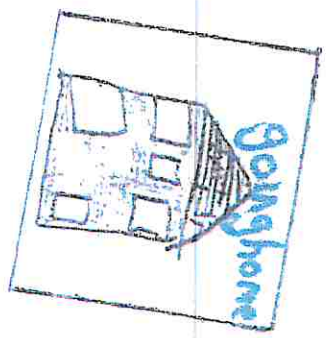
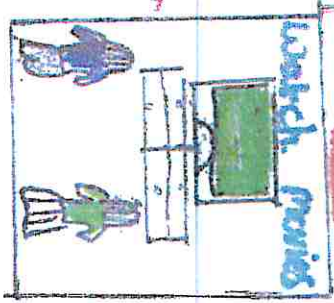
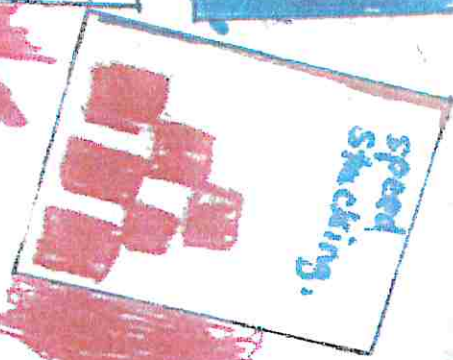
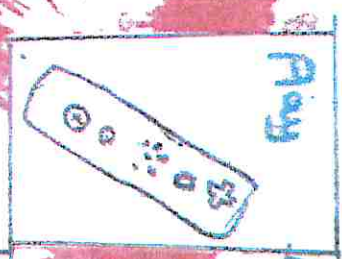
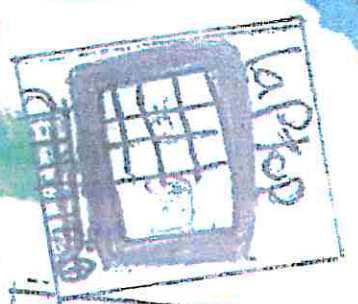
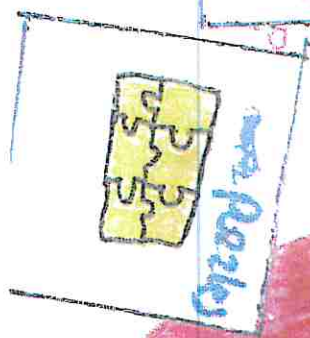
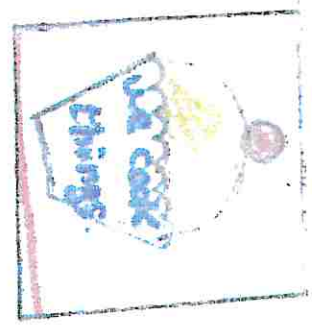
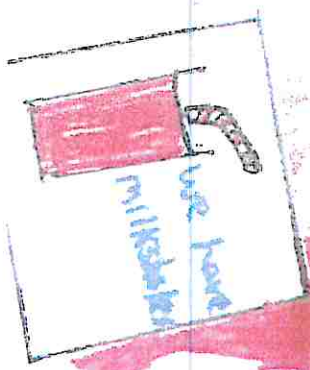

### Holiday Club

Most holiday club provision is run from our sister site at

Elm Grove First School (just a couple of minutes away).

It is open to all children aged 3 to 12 years old in the community, during holiday periods, offering session between 8.00am and 6.00pm.

The Childcare Club provides a wide and varied, ever changing range of activities to suit all ages including arts and crafts, competitions, dancing, I.T, games indoors and out, sports, swimming, dressing up, face painting, discos etc.

Each child under school age will be allocated a key worker, whilst they are in our care, helping them to settle, make friends and join in with activities that are suited to their age.

For Middle School aged children there is an extra room dedicated to them where they can relax and where the activities and equipment are more suited to their ages group.

The club also offers some optional off-site trips and outings, which can be booked separately, some of which may incur an extra charge.

### After School Club

After School Club is open everyday, term time, from the end of the school day. We are able to offer a fun sessions during the afternoon to suit your care requirements.
