There is a new planned development on the Durrington HMRC land with a proposed 287 homes and a care home. As part of this development there are planned improvements to the Barrington Road footpath that runs along the back of West Park Primary school.

The developer, Belway Homes, has committed to improve the Barrington Road footpath. As a community we would like to see the footpath widened, a cycle lane added, good lighting and drainage and the work to be done to a high standard.

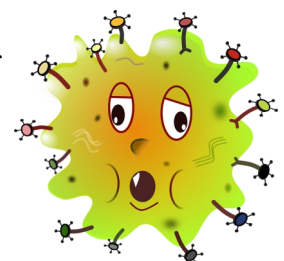
