We have been approached by one of our Year 5 parents, Kasia, who is part of the bigger community that are collecting goods for Ukrainians, organising direct transport to Ukraine and help English families to host Ukrainian families.

They are looking for donations and was hoping our school family could help.

Currently they are in need of:

- baby products (baby food, jars, nappies, modified milk, sudocream)
- medicines (cough mixtures, pain killers, wound dressings, first aid kits)
- instant food/ high calories food
- sanitary products (sanitary pads, nappies for kids and adult size, cleaning products, shampoos, shower gels, toothpaste, tooth brushes, wipes, disinfectants)
- thermal blankets, sleeping bags, foam camping mats

Kasia has offered to collect donations from school and transport to one of their warehouses. Deliveries to Ukraine are going at least 3 times a week at the moment.
